this is my current favourite. Why such lavish praise? Well it is a proper spa. Not a hotel with a spa artached. Everything is geared towards wellness. And you leave feeling lighter, brighter and happier. Who doesn't want tha? Euphoria was created by Marina Eriamoglou, an investment banker.

Efraimoglou, an investment banker who suffered litness and exhaustion, and was born from her desire to create a sanctiunty to help her, and those like her, to recover. And she succeeded, Euphora is perfectly suited to high filers with burnout. There's absolutely no need to stress yourself with
